These are the suggestions from the Council groups:

### Queens

- 1) Make our own reading books to share with other classes. I think this would be a lovely idea to do this as a Christmas story. I am sure that Miss Rickards will enjoy leading on this with you.
- 2) Please can we have another basketball hoop out. Yes, Mr Myhill will do this for you.
- 3) Please can we have some more associate books for the bear project. Miss Rickards is in the process of ordering these.

### Emmanuel

- 1) Please can we have more library books? (Jack mentioned that not all books are out on the shelves currently however so this could be why the question has been asked). Miss Rickards, can you please reply to this?
- 2) Could we have another bring your own electronics items in day? I think this would a good idea nearer to Christmas, depending on Covid restrictions. Mis Burdett, please make a note of this to remind us to discuss at the beginning of December.
- 3) Could we have a reptile day (Academy council agreed that this would be difficult currently with Covid but maybe when things change).
